Characterization/qualification

- ✓ description of the main characters of sites (morphological and topographic characters and of building materials; physical-chemical features; land use; residents and visitors interested in sites);
- ✓ reconstruction of historic events and dynamics of transformation (both natural and cultural, past and recent that led to the current sites set-up);
- √ reading of the social perception of landscape, historicol and contemporary;
- ✓ interpretative description of the current characters of "sites architecture" (intended as morphological organization) and the "ecological functionality" of sites;
- √ identification of strong/key points/areas and of weak/key points/areas
