THEME: Management Plan of Unesco Sites

AREA: Cerveteri, Rome

PROJECT: devising a model for drawing up Management Plans which are currently required by Unesco for the cultural heritage already listed (or going to be listed) in the World Heritage List- WHL.

The Model Management Plan refers to:

1. UNESCO sites listed as “cultural landscapes”
2. the contexts of the so-called “traditional” cultural heritage (either architectural or archeological artifacts) as stated in the New Code of Cultural Heritage and Landscape where for the first time in Italy the principle of landscape protection as interaction between the single items and their context, between architecture and territory, between art and society is guaranteed.
